1. The Event

The event is a demonstration and shall be known as the Pittsworth Sprints Motorkhana Demonstration.
The demonstration is not a competition; the demonstration will not be timed nor will there be a winner.

2. Authority

The demonstration will be conducted under the International Sporting Code of the FIA, the National Competition Rules of Confederation of Australian Motor Sport, the current CAMS Motorkhana Code, the Queensland Appendix, these Supplementary Regulations and any Further Regulations that may be issued.
This Event will be conducted under and in accordance with CAMS OH&S and Risk Management Policies, which can be found on the CAMS website at www.cams.com.au
Insurance will be provided in accordance with Appendix I of the current CAMS Manual.

The demonstration is a component of the Pittsworth Sprints conducted under cover of CAMS Permit Number 408/0709/01.

3. Organiser

5. Entries

Entries for the Pittsworth Sprints Motorkhana Demonstration open with the issue of these regulations and close on Friday 5th September 2008. Entry is **by invitation only**. The maximum number of entries will be 25.

The Pittsworth Sprint Motorkhana Demonstration Entry Fee is \$10.00 (GST inclusive). All entries must be lodged with the secretary of the event on the official entry form. Personal Accident Insurance is included in the entry fee

6. JUDGES OF FACT

The Chief Scrutineer shall be deemed to be a Judge of Fact in respect to:

- (a) Safety of equipment and vehicles.
- (b) That all documents are current and correct.

All officials shall be deemed as Judges of Fact in accordance with Article 18.2 of the National Motorkhana Code.

7. Licences

All competitors / drivers must be a member of a CAMS affiliated car club and be in possession of a relevant and current CAMS licence (minimum L2NS) and hold a valid civil drivers licence. All partnerships and registered companies must hold a CAMS Competitors Licence.

8. Abandonment

The organisers reserve the right to cancel the demonstration if the total number of competitors is less than 15 entries. The demonstration may be altered, postponed, abandoned or cancelled at the sole discretion of the organisers, subject to the provisions of NCR 59.

9. Venue

The demonstration shall be conducted at a temporary venue in Yandina Street, Pittsworth, on Friday 5th September 2008. The type of surface is tarmac.

10. Timetable

Scrutiny will be held at RAFF Farm Supplies / Home Hardware, Yandilla Street, Pittsworth commencing at 6.30 pm Friday 5th September 2008.

A drivers briefing will be held at 7.00 pm at a place to be advised.
The demonstration will start at approximately 7.15 pm and finish at approximately 9.00 pm

11. Scrutiny

Particular heed will be taken to battery security, roadworthy condition of suspension, roll bars, safety harness and tyres as per NCR's. Approved crash helmets and eye protection (not sunglasses) are required for all non-production or open vehicles. All vehicles must be fitted with an effective exhaust silencer system at all times. The maximum noise emission permissible is 95db(A).

All Queensland registered vehicles participating in the demonstration must have a current CTPI extension valid for the activity.

12. Timing

The demonstration is not a competition; the demonstration will not be timed.

13. Tests

Tests, depending on the number of entries, will be advised in further regulations.

14. Use of Prohibited Substances

During any event, consumption of alcoholic beverages in the paddock, pits or any other portion of the competition venue under the control of the officials is expressly forbidden until all practice or competition activity is concluded for each day. Any driver or crew member who is found to be affected by alcohol on the day of the event or practice therefore shall not be permitted to participate. Refer NCR 145A of the Current CAMS Manual. In addition, the persons concerned will be subject to the Articles of the Procedure for Alcohol Testing and CAMS Anti-Doping Policy. Competitors, crews or officials may be tested for alcohol or other drugs at any time during the event(s). This regulation serves as the required 24-hour notice to Competitors, Crew and Officials.

15. General Requirements of Automobiles

Cars must not record sound levels in excess of 95 dBA measured 30m from the track edge at any time.

16. General

Please make sure you have your club membership cards and CAMS licences with you.

A speed limit of 10 kph applies in all immediate areas except the demonstration areas.
